Professor Ahrens is an internationally renowned scholar of civil law and civil procedure, both in academia and in practice. Before taking up the professorship in Göttingen, he had a substantial legal practice, which partly determined his academic research focus. His academic work covers the history of substantive (contract) law and procedural codification, as well as insolvency law (domestic, international and European), which is of particular practical importance. In the field of insolvency law, he is the author and co-author of numerous German commentaries, textbooks and manuals, the author of six monographs or commentaries of monographic size, and has published hundreds of articles. From the beginning he has been an enthusiastic supporter and teaching participant at the ELTE-Göttingen Deutsche Rechtsschule.
