

Title	The Italian Labour Law Legal System: rigidities or flexibility in comparison with Hungary. Which is the other side of the moon?	
Lecturer:	Prof. Andrea Sitzia, Università degli Studi di Padova	
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Brief description

The course aims to focus students' attention on comparative labour law, examining the issue of trade union freedom and collective bargaining law. The issue of control over workers will also be addressed, in order to verify the potential worker rights protection function assigned to collective bargaining in EU Regulation 679/2016. The legislation in force in Italy and the positions of the doctrine will be examined, in relation to the general principles of ILO and EU law in order to stimulate a comparison with the systems of the countries of origin of Erasmus students. The lectures will have a dialogue approach with assignment of tasks to the group that will have to discuss the specific topics. A comparison with the Hungarian legal system is also made in all topics of the course with the help of Hungarian university lecturers.
