The Innovation and Technology Law Summer School addresses emerging issues in the field of technology law, namely exploring the interface between computer science and law and the significant role that law plays in promoting innovation. The Summer School provides participants the opportunity to attend one of the Europe's oldest universities, exchange ideas related to law, technology and innovation in an international environment, and experience cultural outings in a small group setting in Padova and nearby Venice.

TARGET GROUP

Professors, graduate students, research scientists, and professionals who are interested in the intersection of law and innovation. The program is subsidized, with registration limited to 30 applicants.
